COLD WEATHER GUIDELINES:

Parents, please make sure your child comes to school wearing appropriate clothing (gloves, hats, boots, coats, etc.) for keeping warm while outside.

1. Before school – Students may come into the building in the morning before school if either the temperature or the wind chill is -5 degrees or below.

- 2. Recess/Break/Noon hour Elementary students are expected to go outside if temperature or wind chill is above -5 degrees. Middle school students may decide, on their own, to go outside or stay inside.
- 3. Elementary students are required to go outside for recess/noon hour unless there is a written note from the parent indicating a physical condition that does not allow the student to go outside.

SCHOOL CANCELLATION OR DELAY: When school is cancelled due to weather or other circumstances, all after-school or evening event cancellations will be an administrative decision and will depend on the circumstances. This year, we have added the option of a two-hour delay due to weather and/or road conditions. Two hour delay notice and cancellation notices for school and/or evening school-related events will be posted on WOOD TV8 and WZZM TV13 and on our website at www.wscsgr.org. You may sign up for text alerts through these news channels via their websites. School will notify you via email.

Note regarding hot lunch: If school is cancelled on a scheduled hot lunch day, that hot lunch item will be served on the following non-hot lunch day.
