We have lived and experienced so much together, from World War I and II, global pandemics (Various flus, cholera, HIV/AIDS, and COVID), presidential assassination, four school buildings operating at one time, over 600 students enrolled in 1990.

This has already been an extraordinary year in so many ways. While we all have seen significant challenges in 2022, we have also been amazed by God's provision and the faithfulness of His people. We are all doing our part to support the Christ-centered teaching and learning happening each day. God shines His glory through the powerful outdoor learning moments our students experience throughout the seasons. As students take their learning outside you'll notice that it has a positive impact in the nearby

landscape and beyond. Student-led projects increased the native plant populations creating an inviting habitat for butterflies and other important pollinators. Our school garden continues to provide fresh veggies for our Little Sprouts Childcare, a space for intentional learning for our students (including Spanish language development), and fresh produce for community families through donations to the Northwest Food Pantry. In addition, our campus now has a small orchard of fruit producing trees where students develop content skills as they enjoy a fresh seasonal snack. And later this winter, we look forward to tapping the trees for syrup. To God be the glory for the great things He has done!

We appreciate your continued prayers. We have made some progress as we work with the city through the hoophouse/greenhouse permit process. We have added a fence that is a necessary step. There is an upcoming meeting scheduled for the end of September, between Mrs. Staal and the Grand Rapids Assistant Planning Director. We're hopeful as we watch God's plan for our school unfold.
